

*Red by the glass*
**La Maia Lina Chianti 2009 Italy** 7/27

Bright plum, dried cherry and flowers on the nose. Full-bodied, with fine tannins and refined berries finishing with bright acidity. Primarily Sangiovese with Merlot and Cabernet.

**Crios De Susana Balbo Malbec 2010 Argentina** 7/24

Tangy and minerally, this Malbec offers bright aromas and flavors of sweet blueberry and blackberry. Modest notes of vanilla and spice illustrate a judicious use of oak. Straightforward with a juicy finish.

**Grayson Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 CA** 8/28

Rich aromas of dark cherries, blackberries and hints of black pepper. This full bodied wine provides a round mouth feel with a long, lingering finish of hints of toasted oak.

**Lucky Star Pinot Noir 2009 CA** 9/28

Definite fruit, cherries and strawberry, with a little earthiness. Balanced and bold with expressive fruit flavors.

**Charles Smith "Boom Boom" Syrah 2010 WA** 8/28

Deep purple complex, rich and explosive. Think blackberry, lavender, violets and earth. So smooth this wine rocks!

**Foxbrook Merlot 2009 CA** 7/23

The wine starts in the palate with an aromatic fruit bouquet that has the characteristic spice of Merlot fruit. Soft in the middle palate, the silky tannins and delicate balance of acidity and oak make this wine a treat.

*Rosé by the glass*
**Cline Rose 2010 France** 8/28

Pleasant fruit on the nose, plum, pomegranate and cherry dominate, balanced by a delicate hint of sweet anise.


*White by the glass*
**Pomelo Sauvignon Blanc 2010 CA** 7/26

This Sauvignon Blanc is crisp and refreshing. Very expressive with intense grapefruit and lemon aromas. This vintage is very delicate with a polished palate. Excellent pairing with seafood.

**San Pietro Pinot Grigio 2010 Italy** 8/28

With notes of tropical fruit and honey on the nose, this Pinot Grigio has a fruity palate bearing ripe aromas, zinging freshness, balanced intensity and a clean finish

**Alexander Valley Vineyards Chardonnay 2010 CA** 8/27

A beautifully textured Chardonnay that exhibits lush apple and pear flavors along with some tropical fruit notes. Just a touch of vanilla and a hint of minerality.

**Charles Smith "Kung Fu Girl" Riesling 2010 WA** 7/26

A former Rock n Roll manager turned wine maker of truly awesome wines. Long and layered crisp and well balanced. Not overly fruit forward with a perfect amount of dryness on the palate.

**Honig Sauvignon Blanc 2010 Napa, CA** 15

88 pts Wine Spectator. All of the juice is fermented cold, talk about a summer time drink.

**Luigi Bosca La Linda Malbec 2009 Argentina** 12

89 points International Wine Cellar – Luigi would have been my son's name if I were from Argentina

**Yalumba Barossa Shiraz 2008 Australia** 15

91 points Wine Specator – the Barossa Gourmet weekend is a 2 day celebration held every August.

**7 Deadly Zins Zinfandel 2008 Lodi** 17

This flagship Zinfandel is simply delicious. Do yourself a favor and have a few bottles.

**Torii Mor Pinot Noir 2009 Oregon** 18

How cool is this label? Well the juice inside is that much better. Ruby red and full bodied. Try it.

## Red by the bottle

**Bodegas Breton Rioja Lorinon Crianza 2008 Spain 28**

A delicious blend of 85% Tempranillo, 5% Garnacha, 5% Graciano, 5% Mazuelo. Moderate tannins and mellow acidity make this an easy drinking red perfect for grilled steak or roasted chicken.

**Stelzner Napa Valley Claret 2008 CA 34**

Cabernet blended with Merlot from Stags Leap and a small amount of Cabernet Franc. This creamy cassis-laden red is drinking beautifully now with its seamless tannins and supple mix of dark fruit and vanilla.

**Qupé Syrah 2009 CA 34**

Born of ripe, forward fruit from Paso Robles and more lively and spicy fruit from Santa Barbara, this wine is made with early consumption in mind and will pair beautifully with spicier dishes.

**Roth Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 CA 46**

Aged 18 months in French and American oak barrels, it is drinking bright and beautiful now and will continue to gain complexity in the bottle. These grapes are packed with classic varietal character.

**Cliff Lede Breggo Pinot Noir 2009 CA 65**

An Anderson Valley Pinot purchased by Cliff Lede Vineyards, this Pinot is smooth and ripe tasting of candied cherry and rose oil.

**Summers Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 CA 42**

Barrel aging and judicious use of new oak make "Adriannas Cuvee" enjoyable young.

**Silverado Cabernet Sauvignon 2006 CA 65**

A classic Napa Valley Cabernet Sauvignon with ripe jammy fruit and cola aromas coupled with hints of dried herbs is medium to full bodied with cherry, raspberry and mineral flavors.

**Earthquake Cabernet Sauvignon 2009 CA 42**

From the maker that brought you Petite Petit. All varietals under the Earthquake label are Michael and David's reserve level wines. With only a limited production offered each year Earthquake wines are sure to over deliver on all expectations.

**Cliff Lede Cabernet Sauvignon 2008 CA 85**

The 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon Stags Leap District opens with initial scents of rich raspberry, fig compote, nutmeg, cinnamon, and cardamom. This is a well-focused medium-bodied Cabernet.

**Cakebread Cellars Cabernet Sauvignon 2007 CA 100**

The 2005 Cabernet Sauvignon boasts aromas of black fig, blackberry, cassis, caramel, and mocha. Firmly structured and packed with layers of luxurious flavor.

**Michael and David "Petite Petit" 2008 CA 34**

A dense and rich wine full of blueberry, plum, violet with a creamy, polished mouth feel, soft tannins and a seamless finish. 15% Petit Verdot and 85% Petite Sirah make up this fun, luscious blend.

## White by the bottle

**Burgans Albarino 2010 Spain 24**

This delicious wine is fresh and aromatic with vibrant acidity, notes of ripe apples and peaches. The unique soil and the Atlantic climate allows the mythical Albarino grape to reach its fullest expression.

**Cliff Lede Sauvignon Blanc 2007 CA 40**

The superb fruit from top Napa Valley sites allows Cakebread to produce a crisp, full-bodied, complex Sauvignon Blanc of distinctive varietals character.

**Charles Smith "Eve" Chardonnay 2009 WA 26**

Sinfully Tempting! The perfume of sweet apple blossoms lures you into The Garden of Eden. Silky, soft, mouth filling deliciousness...take the first sip!

**Cakebread Cellars Chardonnay 2007 CA 50**

Displays vibrant citrus blossom, ripe apple, sweet melon and white peach aromas. Rich, fresh and creamy on the palate, it is delightful now with rich seafood and white meat dishes.
